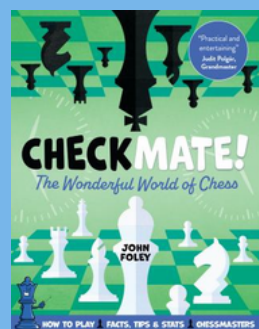

January is National Braille Literacy Month

Wolfner Library is a specialized library service targeted at Missourians who qualify based on their inability to use standard print materials due to various impairments. Individuals who are blind, visually impaired, physically impaired, or have a reading disability are eligible to benefit from Wolfner Library's offerings.



The primary aim of Wolfner Library is to provide accessible materials in various formats, including braille, audio, and large print, ensuring that individuals with print-related difficulties can still access a wide range of content.

The services offered by Wolfner Library include two prominent programs: Talking Book and Braille Library. The Talking Book program provides access to a diverse collection of audio materials, including books and other publications, enabling users to listen to content rather than relying on traditional print. On the other hand, the Braille Library program caters specifically to those who read Braille, offering a collection of materials in this tactile format.
