

# Battle of the Books

## Trivia Contest

### Registration

Please join the Heartland Regional Library as we encourage students to read more and to help them find interesting books to read. Our library is organizing trivia contests to be held in March, to challenge student knowledge of books they have read from the Missouri Association of School Librarian's (MASL) nominated lists.

- \* Gateway - Students who are attending high school (grades 9 – 12)
- \* Truman – Students who are attending junior high school (grades 6-8)
- \* Mark Twain – Students who are attending upper elementary school (grades 4 – 6).

Before the event, each team will read all of the titles from the list of nominated books at their grade level. The more students on a team, the better, however, there is a limit of ten students allowed to a team. Each team member is not limited to but should be expected to read one or two books from the list. Schools may enter more than one team. Trivia contests will consist of ten rounds with twelve to fifteen questions each (one question per book per round). Tie-breaker = extra round(s). One point will be awarded for each correct answer. There will be no cost to enter these contests. Check Heartland's web site often for updates.
